

Highway Element Public Survey



Generally, the Mobile MPO funds projects that are additional capacity in nature on arterial roadways that are normally not maintained by ALDOT. This means adding lanes to a road (on “unshielded” routes), or building a new road. The MPO funding category is called STP Attributable, is \$8.5 Million per year (federal + local match), and is spent at the MPO's discretion. Over the next 25 years, there is \$212.5 Million worth of projects to be programmed in Destination 2040. There will be several sets of “Alternatives” that will be a combination of projects totaling to the estimated \$212.5 Million that will be tested in the travel demand forecast model. Before we start testing alternates, we want to know what is important to you.

Public input is an essential part of the Plan's creation and your participation in the survey is appreciated.

The MPO is looking for responses from anyone who either lives or works in the Mobile metropolitan area.
